**Abstract:** The liberalization of the power sector has profound implications within the broader context of energy policy. The design and administration of electricity markets has focused on improving efficiency, which is an important but only one of several energy policy objectives. To achieve other objectives both within the power sector and energy policy in general, the integration of large-scale models and the presentation of their results within a more comprehensive energy policy framework are necessary.
