

NJ Watershed Restoration & Adaptation Planning

The NJ Department of Environmental Protection and Rutgers University are developing a web-based application to support comprehensive watershed management.



The NJ Watershed Restoration & Adaptation Planning (NJWRAP) application will help:

- Identify actions to improve water quality
- Select locations for restoration, best management practices, and green infrastructure
- Identify water quality stressors
- Develop watershed plans, including MS4 watershed improvement plans and EPA 9-point plans
- Assess and inform environmental policy
- Identify and prioritize potential compliance assistance

Summarized watershed indicators and guidance for improving water quality.



Water Quality Stressors and Opportunities Tool

Information to help identify impairments and restoration opportunities.
